After an exhaustive search, we are thrilled that Rebekah has accepted our offer to join the New Century Family. Rebekah comes to New Century from New York City, where she has been Director of Programs and Development for the Opus 118 Harlem Music School. As head of the Opus 118 organization, Rebekah oversaw one of the most impressive after school music programs in the country. Opus118 is most famous for its group violin instruction for young students, and has expanded to offerings to meet the needs of the Harlem community by offering students private, partner, and group instruction in a variety of instruments.

Her impressive track record of fundraising, and programmatic leadership at Opus 118 translates beautifully to our programs and aspirations for New Century.

A graduate of Mount Holyoke College, and the Zicklin School of Business at Baruch College in New York City, Rebekah has an impressive career history in the arts.
